Introduction

Enterprise State Community College's Campus Security Report includes crime statistics and prevention information to assist students, faculty, and staff in making decisions which affect their personal safety and that are required by the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act. These statistics reflect a 3 year period of calendar years 2007 through 2009. The data for 2007 and 2008 is a composite score of all campus crime statistics reflected in the Enterprise campus reporting table. Data for the calendar year 2009 is reported under the heading of each campus: Enterprise, Ozark, and Mobile. The U.S. Department of Education Office of Postsecondary Education does not consider Ft. Rucker, Andalusia, and Albertville as campuses for the purposes of this report, but considers them to be instructional sites; therefore crime statistics for these three locations are not included in this report. The data reflected in this report was reported from the local law enforcement agencies as of October 1, 2010. If additional 2009 data is reported between October 1 and October 15, 2010, by the respective local police agencies, then the crime statistics contained within this report will be updated and published on the College's website and available in the Dean of Students office.

Campus Law Enforcement Policies

Enterprise State Community College is committed to promoting a safe and secure campus. The College Security staff provides the Enterprise and Ozark campuses with protection. All campuses are supported and protected by the local police departments in the respective cities where the College campuses are located or the military police at Ft. Rucker. The College security staff supports the College's mission and continually seeks ways to improve the safety and security of the College by working in partnership with students, faculty, and staff. Campus Security actively investigates problems and incidents, and searches for positive solutions to support a sense of security throughout the College. ESCC maintains an open campus environment and encourages the community to participate in activities that are open to the public. However, the College reserves the right to restrict unauthorized persons from its grounds when appropriate.

College security is staffed by a variety of off-duty police officers, private security guards, one full-time employee who serves as a security guard and courier for the College, and one part-time employee who serves as a security guard. Uniformed officers and/or security guards patrol the campus using marked police cars, and/or foot patrols. The off-duty police officers working as College security are empowered to arrest any offender if necessary. College security who are not police officers do not carry weapons nor have arrest powers; however, they call the local police when back-up is needed. Likewise, the Dean of Students is responsible for on-campus disciplinary proceedings. College security and the Dean of Students staff work collaboratively to resolve incidents of student misconduct that involve College policy and procedures.

The Dean of Students office and College Security encourages accurate and prompt reporting of all crime. College security investigates incidents of a criminal nature and involves the local police department. If needed, assistance is available from not only the local police departments,

but also from the respective sheriff departments, Alabama Highway Patrol, Alabama Bureau of Criminal Identification, and the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

Emergency Response and Evacuation Procedures

Emergency Response and Evacuation Procedures:

The following procedures are utilized when College Security is notified about a potential life safety situation that affects the ESCC campus and/or its constituents off campus.

- The Switchboard operator, Dean of Students office, or President's office receives notification of a potential life safety emergency.
- The staff member calls security to verify the situation immediately.
- The Security Officer determines whether the situation necessitates the notification of the campus community.
- If the Incident Commander deems immediate notification should be disseminated to the campus community, a message is sent by the following means:
 - Weevil Cast text message
 - Email to students, faculty, and staff from the President or the Dean of Students
 - College home page.
- Once the initial information has been shared with the campus community, the office of the Dean of Students and the office of Institutional Advancement will take on the role of continued communication with the campus community.
- The President or Dean of Students will send an "All Clear" message when the situation is over.

The above procedures will be acted upon without delay when a life safety issue is reported. Officers will be immediately dispatched to the scene of the life safety situation in order to verify the situation and gather further information. The content of the message sent to the campus community will be determined by the College President and Dean of Students in conjunction with the office of Institutional Advancement as appropriate. Further, the President or Dean of Students is responsible for determining which component(s) of the campus community will be notified of the potential life safety situation (ex. Enterprise campus, Ozark, etc).

Information will not be shared with the campus community when the President or Dean of Students determines that doing so would compromise the efforts of assisting those in distress.

Information will also be shared with the respective local police agencies when necessary so they may assist in handling the situation and share information with the wider community.

The following departments are responsible for initiating the notification of the campus community in a potential life safety situation:

- President's office, Dean of Students office, Institutional Advancement, College security, and Information Technology

Additional means of providing on-going information concerning a potential life safety situation and its resolution include:

- Campus emails
- Weevil College Cast phone and text messages
- Messages on Weevil Vision
- College home page, Facebook, etc.
- Communication with College security and other emergency agencies
- Communication with local media outlets

To better prepare in the event of an emergency situation, Enterprise State Community College tests the emergency notification process once during each academic year with the entire campus community.
