I. Minimum Qualifications:

A. Aviation Maintenance Technology courses

Associate degree*. FAA Airframe and Powerplant Mechanic certification, and six (6) years' full-time work experience in the field. *(degree may be waived in certain circumstances)

B. Avionics Technology courses

Bachelor's degree* and six (6) years' full-time work experience in the field. Must hold FCC General Radiotelephone certificate *(degree may be waived in certain circumstances)

II. Course Days/Times

Courses are available Monday thru Friday at a variety of times, during the day and evening, on our campuses and site locations.

Term Length

Fall/Spring Semester - approximately 15 weeks.

Summer Semester - approximately 10 weeks

IV. Application Procedure

- A. A letter of application stating what subject you are interested in teaching, times that you would be available to teach, and campus or campuses where you would be willing to teach (Enterprise, Ft. Rucker, Ozark, Mobile).

- C. A current resume
- D. A copy of certification, license and transcripts. If you are hired, you must provide official transcripts from all institutions attended.

You will be notified of the results and a copy will be sent to the chair of the department for which you applied. The Director of Aviation Center, Ozark Campus, will serve as your point of contact and will notify you if a position becomes available.
