

MISSING DOCUMENT DESCRIPTIONS

Application for Admission to EOCC - You must be admitted to EOCC as a regular student in a degree or certificate program before your application for financial aid can be considered.

EOCC Student Data Form – Complete all items on both sides of this form and return it to the EOCC Financial Aid Office on your campus.

Institutional Verification Form (IVF) – Complete all items on both sides of this form and return it directly to the EOCC Financial Aid Office on your campus. Take special care to follow the instructions given on the IVF when listing members of your household.

Pell Grant Student Aid Report (SAR) – Your SAR will be mailed directly to you from the Pell Grant processor. Submit a signed original copy of your SAR to the Financial Aid Office only if it is requested.

U.S. Income Tax Return/s for 2008 – **All returns MUST be signed by at least one of the people whose name is listed as a filer of the return.** Students, student's parents, and student's spouse who have not and will not file a 2008 U.S. Income Tax return should indicate this on the IVF form (see above). Also- students, spouses, and parents must provide a copy of their 2008 W-2 forms.

Social Security Documentation – If requested, you must provide the Financial Aid Office with a copy of the SSA-1099 form for each person in your household who received Social Security benefits in 2008. This form is a summary of all Social Security benefits received during the 2008 calendar year.

Official Transcripts – Please submit official transcripts from the school(s) listed.
