## COMPUTERS FOR SENIORS

This is a beginning computer class designed exclusively for seniors with limited computer experience. Students will be introduced to the Internet and learn how to set up a free e-mail account, be introduced to the computer keyboard, taught basic computer terminology, and get hands-on experience with the Microsoft Word software package. At the conclusion of this four-session course, students should be able to overcome their fear of computer usage, understand the basic functions of a computer keyboard, and gain a sense of the potential for computer use in their home, work, and/or educational environment.
