

Adult Education Classes

Adult education classes provide a second opportunity for adult learners committed to improving their academic and life skills. Learning opportunities include GED preparation classes, basic skills classes for reading and math, literacy instruction for adults learning to read, and English as a Second Language classes. Instruction is based on individual student needs and may range from one-on-one tutoring to group instruction. Computer-based and distance education instructional programs are offered, as well as day and evening classes, in a variety of facilities conducive to adult learning. All classes are free! Eligible participants must be 17 years of age or older and not enrolled in public school.

An Assessment Test is required prior to attending classes.
