Most professors want students to succeed, and they often offer advice to that end. There are some common sense steps to not only getting good grades, but also to get the most out of your college experience. College is about being an active learner and taking responsibility for your own actions.



Ways to Succeed in College:

- Attend every class and participate. Ask questions. Chances are if you don't understand what was presented, several others didn't either.
- Attend supplemental instruction sessions. Classes are designed to challenge students so don't be afraid to ask for help or attend special tutorial sessions.
- Make sure you understand everything before getting to the night before a test.
- Study your notes every night and review any materials, including the textbook, as often as you can to avoid cramming. Keep up with reading and assignments. Follow your syllabus closely.
- Join clubs in areas that interest you and participate. Be in leadership positions or roles in at least one activity.
- Have a hobby. Students need to be as well rounded in college as they were in high school.
