What is WebCat (ESCC Library Online Catalog)?



ESCC Online Catalog (WebCat) provides access to books (including eBooks) that are non-fiction and fiction, government documents, and audio-visual materials. Materials except those located in the reference and genealogy collection are available for check out. *This handout will provide you with step-by-step instructions on how to locate materials within the Enterprise, Ozark, and Mobile libraries.*

How Do I Access WebCat?

- Type in this URL: <http://www.esccl.edu>.
- Click on *Library* on the right.
- Click on **Resources**
- Find **Books**
- Click search the **ESCC Online Database**.
- Choose **Quick Search**.
- Type in a *keyword* for your topic.
- Click on **Search Everything**.
- The **call number** for each item will appear **bolded**. *This information will indicate how to locate the item on the shelf.*



Finding an eBook

1. eBooks will be indicated as **Online** or as **None**.
1. Click on the **View blue bullet next to each item**.
2. An **Electronic Access** link will appear at the bottom of the record to access the eBook.

What Information Can I Find in the ESCC Catalog?

Through WebCat, you will find for each item:

- The holding library location: ESJCLIB, ESJCOZARK, ESJCMOBILE
- The area of the library in which the item is located
- The number of copies owned
- The year of publication
- Call Numbers- Library of Congress

1. After clicking on **Electronic Access**, in the above directions, the following password information is required: *User ID (eozark); Password (ebSCO)*.

How Do I Access AVL?

Using the Library Computers:

- Type in this URL: <http://www.avl.lib.al.us>.
- Click on *View All Resources* in the **top tab bar**.
- Choose the database that you wish to use.

After Choosing a Database:

- **Limit Your Results** by selecting the Full-Text box.
- For **professional journal articles**, place a check mark by Scholarly (Peer Reviewed) Journals.
- In the **Find** box, type your subject and click the **Search** button.

- Academic Search Premier - focuses on general interest and a wide variety of topics.
- Health Source: Consumer Edition: - consumer health information on a variety of topics including psychology and general health.
- Literature Resources from Gale - contains literary criticism and biographical information about authors.
- Military & Government Collection - covers news on all branches of the military and government.
- Opposing Viewpoints in Context – provides perspectives on controversial issues (*excellent for argumentative papers or speeches*).
- Vocational and Career Collection – features articles from trade and industry-related publications.
